**Thursday, April 29th: Bryan Mark Taylor Demonstration.** Bay area artist Taylor will demonstrate his oil painting techniques at 7 p.m. at the Art Center, 1817 Eye Street. He

is well known to local art enthusiasts from his successful one-man show at the Bakersfield Museum of Art in 2007 and at the painting workshops that he teaches in Bakersfield each year. In his own words, "I believe the beauty of nature can inspire and uplift the human heart and mind", and truly Taylor's landscape and cityscape paintings, mostly executed en plein air, are beautiful to behold. **Friday, May 21st: Sharon Schwenk Demonstration.**

North Carolina artist Schwenk, who hails from Bakersfield and a long line of painters, will be returning to town to give an oil painting demo at our Art Center. She began the serious study of painting after seeing the collection of the Impressionist paintings at the National Gallery of Art in Washington, D.C., and working closely with her teacher and friend, Connie Winters, she learned fast and began winning awards at painting competitions on the East Coast. ## ART CENTER COMMITTEE REPORT

(by Ann Sullivan, Manager)

Members present: Ann Sullivan, manager; Iva Fendrick, Heartha Flesher, Richard Geissel, Fred Jacober, Toni Lott, Joyce Ogborn, Coral Poole-Clark and Shirley Rowles.

First Friday was very successful with lots of people visiting the Art Center, with many sales amounting to nearly \$600. Both Bakersfield Life Magazine and Bright House Network were on the scene. We had many volunteers demonstrating art, talking to the public about the Art Center, as well as providing refreshments and music. In the future, we need to have someone on the mezzanine to talk about the art there.

We need a temporary sign in the window to let public know of our hours and days of operation, along with a flyer about the Grand Opening and hours, to be handed out and distributed to businesses to post.

Since there is presently no room for storing participants' art, they should be called as soon as there is a sale so their work can be replaced as soon as possible. Owners of items not used on a regular basis will be asked to pick them up to free up more storage space. To provide more exhibit space, more work is required upstairs; and another gallon of paint is needed. The wall behind the office area has been finished and looks very nice.

Discussion followed about improvements to exhibit space; gallery look vs wallpaper effect (i.e., uniform framing, more spacing between works); all name cards to be uniformly placed 4 inches about the red line; sign needed indicating more art upstairs; and information about classes visible to the public.

More volunteers needed for jobs that Shirley has been doing, i.e., someone to do newsletter cover to be sent to newsletter editor (Stella Mullins), someone to send contracts and follow up letters to featured and guest artists (Charlotte White), and to maintain a calendar for deadlines (Charlotte), someone to maintain instruction (Kathy Pope) and training manuals, and someone to create ads for Californian (Emily Mbong). Ann will create and maintain signs for Art Center as well as make invitation cards for guest artists and Art Center artists.

The telephone greeting will be updated. The wording on page 3 of the participants' contract has been revised to clarify due dates for payment of space rent. Discussion followed regarding finding money in the budget to make one or more ads in color. Also discussion of interest in having polymer art displayed and the possibility of classes for the making of it.

There are already a number of activities scheduled for May and June!
